

Agenda Item for approval under Automatic Approval Scheme.

M/s. Harmony Plastics Pvt. Ltd., Sabarkantha.

M/s. Harmony Plastics Pvt. Ltd., Unit-IV, 205/1 paiki 2, Village Bhavpur, Taluka Himatnagar, Dist. Sabarkantha-383030 has submitted an application for setting up of new unit for manufacturing of PP Woven Fabric Laminated or Unlaminated (Roofing Fabric) HDPE Woven Fabric Laminated or Unlaminated (Roofing Fabric), PP Woven Bags/Sacks Laminated or Unlaminated, HDPE Woven Bags/Sacks Laminated or Unlaminated, Non Woven Fabric Laminated or Unlaminated, Articles of Laminated / Unlaminated Non Woven Fabrics, Reprocessed Granules/Granules, PP/HDPE Tape.

The nature of the applicant firm is **Private Limited Company**. The company has eight Directors having vast experience in the field of manufacturing and export of the plastic products and it has a 100% EOU operational unit at Udaipur. The firm is part of Mewar Group of Companies, specialized in manufacturing of plastic products. Mewar Group is operating a SEZ unit in Sachin, Surat in the name of Harmony Plastics Pvt. Ltd.

The total project cost is Rs.1381 lakhs which will be financed from own sources and Bank Loan. The unit will provide employment to around 195 employees over a period of 5 years. Other features of the project are as under:

As per the manufacturing process furnished by the applicant and as detailed in the project report, they will convert the HDPE/PP granules into tapes, the granules will be melted in extruder and will polymerize into a molten mass. By application of appropriate pressure a film, of desired gauge is obtained in a semi-finished condition. The film will be cooled with the help of water then it is slit into strips with the help of blades fixed on a cutter. After silting, the strips are stretched with the help of heat and converted into tapes. The tapes will be woven on circular weaving looms and will be sent to lamination machine. The fabric is coated with a thin film of plastic and smaller rolls converted into bigger rolls and wound on paper core-pipes to be exported.

Comments and Recommendations:

The proposal meets with other requirements of approval under EOU Scheme under the Automatic Approval route. Therefore, the proposal is placed before UAC for consideration.
