

Minutes of the 1st Meeting (2016 Series) of the Units Approval Committee (UAC) for EOUs held on 04.01.2016 at 13:00 Hrs. in the Office Chamber of the Development Commissioner, Administrative Building, Kandla SEZ, Gandhidham under the Chairpersonship of Shri Upendra Vasishth, ndc, Development Commissioner, KASEZ

(i) M/s. Arysta LifeScience India Ltd., Kalol, Panchmahal

The proposal is for establishment of a new unit under EOU scheme at 229-230, Kalol Notified Area, Kalol, Panchmahal – 389 330 for manufacturing of Agrochemical Formulations – Emulsifiable Concentrate (EC), Suspension Concentrate (SC), etc.

Shri Daxesh Mankad, Head of Supply Chain of the company appeared before the UAC for personal interview and explained about the proposal. Shri Daxesh Mankad gave a brief about their company and stated that their company was first to get the ISO Registration in Agrochemical Formulations in the country. In March, 2011 M/s. Arysta LifeScience Corporation, their Parent Company, had taken majority interest in Devidayal Sales Ltd., which was established in 1949 and are offering products under the brand name of “Devidayal Agrochemicals”. The name of the company was changed from M/s. Devidayal (Sales) Ltd. to M/s. Arysta LifeScience India Ltd. vide Certificate of Incorporation dated 11.02.2014. They are having a modern manufacturing plant at Kalol and they run the same as a DTA unit. The domestic market is catered to from its 21 warehouses spread all over India. Now, they want to set up a new manufacturing unit nearby their exiting DTA unit to cater to International market.

On being pointed out by the Chairman regarding registration of their products proposed to be manufactured under the EOU Scheme from Central Insecticides Board, Shri Mankad stated that they already have registration from Central Insecticides Board for 313 products and for manufacturing the said products under EOU Scheme they will intimate the Central Insecticides Board and get endorsement in Licence from the Central Insecticides Board for further location i.e. the EOU location.



Observation/Decision of the Committee:

- Projected Export for the 5 year period is Rs. 31435.19 lakhs
- Investment in Plant and Machinery will be Rs. 183.95 lakhs which will be procured indigenously.
- Net Foreign Exchange Earnings projected for the 5 year period is Rs. 23773.34 lakhs.

The proposal meets with the requirement of approval under EOU Scheme under the Automatic Approval Route. The Committee therefore, decided to approve the proposal subject to standard terms and conditions.
