Approved minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed by the Approval Committee.


A) Other case:-

17-A-01) Monitoring of Performance of SEZ units in GIDC-SAP-SEZ, in respect of performance up to the monitoring year 2016-17.

The Development Commissioner/Approval Committee had granted approvals for 45 (forty-five) entrepreneurs/units in GIDC-SAP-SEZ, Schin, Surat, out of which 10 (ten) units went into operations. In terms of provisions of Rule 22 of the Special Economic Zones Rules, 2006, these operational SEZ units are required to submit their respective Annual Performance Reports (APR) in prescribed format i.e. Form-I to the Development Commissioner of SEZ and the same needs to be placed before the Approval Committee for consideration. The units have to submit their APRs duly audited and certified by independent Chartered Accountant appointed by the unit.

The submitted APRs by the SEZ units were scrutinized by the Development Commissioner's office and various discrepancies were noticed which are of fundamental nature. In all cases the SEZ units were given query letters to comply with. The Approval Committee after carefully examining/reviewing the query letters issued by DC's office, has shown their displeasure at the SEZ units, ~~while filing APR has not taken due care~~ *for the fact that no care is taken by units in filing APRs.*

The Approval Committee was very critical, and viewed seriously regarding non-submission of the mandatory APR in proper way by the units in SAP-SEZ, Sachin, Surat. All SEZ units are required to submit their respective revised APRs duly corrected and certified by CA with 3 weeks time period to enable DC's Office to conduct scrutiny. The Approval Committee directed the Development Commissioner's office and the Specified Officer to take-up all cases one by one and impart proper guidance to the SEZ units for a just and proper filing of the mandatory APRs (manually and online version). Thereafter, the rectified and proper CA certified APRs received from individual SEZ units to be scrutinized and verified by the internal auditor appointed for the said purpose and to be finally put-up before this Approval Committee for its complete monitoring and review. This process is to be completed in a time bound manner and report to this Approval Committee with all details during first week of March, 2018.
