

**Minutes of the 8<sup>th</sup> Meeting (2017 Series) of the Units Approval Committee (UAC) for EOUs held on 16.05.2017 at 11:30 Hrs. in the Office Chamber of the Development Commissioner, Administrative Building, Kandla SEZ, Gandhidham under the Chairpersonship of Shri Upendra Vasishth, ndc, Development Commissioner, KASEZ**

**M/S. KOSHAMBH MULTITRED PVT. LTD., VADODARA**

The proposal is for conversion of their existing DTA unit into EOU at Plot No. 205, GIDC Halol, Panchmahals – Gujarat for manufacturing of Plastic Carry Bags.

Shri Rajendran K. R., Export Manager and Shri Shiv Kumar, Deputy Manager of the company appeared before the UAC for personal interview and explained about the proposal. Shri Rajendran K. R. gave a brief about their company and clarifies all the points raised by the Committee's members.

The Committee asked Shri Rajendran to submit the details of export for last 3 years for the unit which is to be converted into 100% EOU under Automatic route.

Observation/Decision of the Committee:

- Projected Export for the 5 year period is Rs 8255.74 lakhs
- Net Foreign Exchange Earnings projected for the 5 year period is Rs. 795.57 lakhs.

The proposal meets with the requirement of approval under EOU Scheme under the Automatic Approval Route. The Committee, therefore, decided to approve the proposal subject to standard terms and conditions and submission of relevant documentary proof relating to turnover of the unit.

**M/s. BASF INDIA LTD., ANKLESHWAR**

M/s. BASF India Ltd. Ankleshwar is a working unit for manufacture and export of Color former, Developer & their Intermediates. The unit has requested for broad-banding of Lupasol PA 140 a new product in their LOP which is falling under ITC (HS) Code No. 39069090. Shri Nileshkumar Rana, Manager-warehouse and Shri Shailesh Parmar, Assistant Manager-Warehouse of the company appeared before the UAC for personal interview and explained about the proposal. Shri Nileshkumar has stated that for their new product new machine are required and their production capacity will be increased. Further, they have stated that they have taken required permission from concerned department for their new product.

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On being pointed out by the Chairman whether they have fixed norms for their product, Shri Kumar has stated that they will apply for adhoc norms.

The Committee had detailed discussion about similarity of proposed product with their existing product and decided that although the proposed product is dissimilar in nature but fall under the similar categories of chemical, therefore, approved the product for broad banding.

**M/s. TRIVEDI TECHTONICS, AHMEDABAD**

M/s. Trivedi Techtonics, Ahmedabad, was approved for manufacturing and export of Worked/ Carved stone for Monuments/ Building (ITC HS Code No. 68021000), Stone craft articles (ITC HS Code No. 68021000), Dressed Stone blocks (ITC HS Code No. 68022110) etc. vide LOP dated 01.03.2004 as amended. The unit has requested for broad banding of following new product in their LOP.



Shri Ajit Patel, Excise Manager of the company appeared before the UAC for personal interview and explained about the proposal.

On being pointed out by the Chairman whether they import any raw material or will they make any DTA Sales for their proposed new product, Shri Patel has stated that they procure the raw material indigenously and will not make any DTA Sales. The Committee specifically observed that DTA Sale of marble is not allowed.

The Committee, therefore, decided to approve proposal subject to no importation of raw material or DTA sales of Handicraft Stone Product (Marble) *will be allowed.*
