Approved minutes of the previous meeting was confirmed by the Approval Committee

A) Fresh proposal for Jubilant – Chemicals - SEZ:-

27-A-01) Project proposal of M/s. Jubilant Life Sciences Ltd. (Unit-4), Bharuch:-

Shri Ashok Gupta, DGM-SCM of the applicant company appeared before the Committee for personal interview, and explained about the proposed project. The proposal is to set up a new unit for manufacture and export of "Acetic Anhydride".

- Proposed investment is Rs. 90.00 with employment generation of 100 persons;
- Projected FOB value of exports is Rs. 1120.00 crores, with foreign exchange outgo of Rs. 724.25 crores, resulting NFE earnings of Rs. 395.75 crores (35.33%);
- The Developer M/s. Jubilant Infrastructure Ltd., has provided space for the proposed project at Plot No P1 – L19 in the SEZ.

During the course of discussion it was observed by the Approval Committee that the proposed item for manufacture & export sought for approval "Acetic Anhydride" is an item allowed is free for export subject to No Objection Certificate from Narcotics Commissioner of India, Gwalior, as a licensing condition in the Foreign Trade Policy in force. Further, the applicant had informed the Approval Committee for manufacture & export of the aforesaid finished product the basic/key raw material are 1) Acetic Acid – ITC No. 29152100; and 2) Tri ethyl Phosphate – ITC No. 29199090, which are free for import and exports.

The Committee after due diligence and deliberation agreed to approve the project, subject to standard terms and conditions, of the SEZ Rules, 2006, and further the applicant obtaining all mandatory/statutory approvals from all concerned Regulatory Authorities including adhering to stipulated existing environment and pollution control norms before commencement of production and export. The applicant to further ensure all licensing conditions of the Foreign Trade Policy and Import Trade Control (Harmonized System) Classifications of export and import items, including SCOMET (if applicable) are adhered/fulfilled before commencement of exports. Specified Officer of the SEZ shall ensure all regulatory stipulations are adhered to by the manufacturer/exporter, *before operations are permitted.*
