

Customs is the nodal agency to record, maintain and provide statistical data related exports Imports. Customs is the primary source of this information and controls 100% of India's foreign Trade totaling to billions of records.

Your Office has spent almost 1000 crores of Citizen's money to create, consolidate and maintain IT Automation projects called ICES 1.5 and ICES 1. Your office has a world class datacenter, systems, personnel and requisite and world class IT vendors like Oracle, HP, TCS, consultants like Price Water House Coopers, teams of programmers, System Managers, and database administrators to record, update, maintain and extract necessary information.

Kindly go through the Section 4 (1), and 4 (2) of RTI Act 2005, which clearly states that your office is under obligation to provide information.

4. (1) Every public authority shall—
a) maintain all its records duly catalogued and indexed in a
manner and the form which facilitates the right to information
under this Act and ensure that all records that are appropriate
to be computerized are, within a reasonable time and subject to
availability of resources, computerized and connected through a
network all over the country on different systems so that access
to such records is facilitated;

Sir, my request is of urgent nature, it concerns a research project and pertains to national public interest, I most respectfully and humbly request you not to wait for 30 days to provide information or reject information.

I reproduce Section 7 (1) of RTI act:

7. (1) Subject to the proviso to sub-section (2) of section 5 or the proviso to sub-section (3) of section 6, the Central Public Information Officer or State Public Information Officer, as the case may be, on receipt of a request under section 6 shall, as expeditiously as possible, and in any case within thirty days of the receipt of the request, either provide the information on payment of such fee as may be prescribed or reject the request for any of the reasons specified in sections 8 and 9:

M. Conclusion

Respected Sir, since It is a crucial issue I have tried to make a conscientious RTI request and have tried to the best of my ability to make the request as clear as possible to help you take a informed and conscientious decision.

I apologize for mistakes if any in my language, lengthy explanations, and references to RTI act which may take away your precious time.

However this has been done to save time later by avoiding to drag the matter to First Appeal and Second Appeal at CIC, which frustrates RTI act and also is a burden on existing already overloaded judicial resources.

I again repeat that I do not wish to seek monetary or administrative penalties on you or contest you before First Appellate Authority and before CIC.

I rather most humbly and respectfully request you not to reject my request but examine its merits conscientiously and help me and proactively assist me in providing information as specified under Section 5 (3) of RTI act as a Quasi Judicial Authority and go beyond the "Administrative convenience" of your office and perform the "quasi-judicial" role, under the RTI Act 2005, with due diligence, following the principles of natural justice and respecting the RTI Act in letter and spirit.

Please refer to your RTI application dated 01.10.2019, received by this office on 07.10.2019.

In this context, it is to inform that the information sought vide above RTI application is a similar to your earlier RTI application which was already rejected/returned by this office vide letter dated 18.09.2019.

Further, your kind attention is invited towards the Circular No. 03/03/2017 dated 10.03.2017 issued by the Central Vigilance Commission (CVC), New Delhi regarding "Seeking similar information through repeated RTI applications" and Central Information Commission's decision No. CIC/AD/A/2013/001326-SA dated 25.06.2014 wherein it has been decided that:-

"(i) No scope of repeating under RTI Act.

(ii) Citizen has no Right to Repeat.

(iii) Repetition shall be ground of refusal.

(iv) Appeals can be rejected."

Further, your kind attention is also invited towards the Central Information Commission's decision No. CIC/AD/A/2010/000931 dated 10th August, 2010 wherein it has been decided that:-

"The Appellant is advised to refrain from seeking the same information several time, obviously with an intent to harass the Public Authority and that any appeal to the Commission in future on the same subject will not be entertained by the Commission."

In view of above, your RTI application dated 01.10.2019 has been rejected.

This information is being supplied under section 7 of the RTI Act, 2005. In case, the applicant is not satisfied with the information supplied, he may prefer an appeal within 30 days from the receipt of this information before the Development Commissioner, KASEZ, Gandhidham.
