

Minutes of 35th(Thirty-Fifth) meeting of the Approval Committee for sector specific Electronic Park – Special Economic Zone developed by Gujarat Industrial Development Corporation (GIDC) held on 22-01-2019, at 1500 hours under Chairmanship of Dr. Amiya Chandra, Development Commissioner, Kandla Special Economic Zone, at City Office, 1, NBCC Building, Opp. Panjrapole BRTS, Polytechnic, Ahmedabad.

Approved minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed by the Approval Committee.

35-A-01 Request of M/s. Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd. for inclusion of "Services" for authorized operations in the existing Letter of Approval (LOA) issued vide Ref. No. SEZ/GIDC/U/14/ALT/477 dated 26.02.2010, valid upto 05/6/2021.

Shri Bhupendra S. Shah, Director of the applicant firm M/s. Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd., appeared before the Approval Committee for personal interview. He mentioned that at present the company is engaged in manufacturing items, approved by the UAC, i.e. "Equipment for laboratories such as Bottle Top Dispenser, Burette Pipette Controller, Pipettes of different volumes and channels, Accessories, Spares and Consumables, Centrifuge tubes, micro plates, Tissue Culture Plates and cyroware." He explained that the company is marketing their products in various countries and it has got good marketing expertise in the line of exports in more than 100 countries. The company has been approached by overseas OEM (Original Equipments Manufacturers) customers and International Distributors to exclusively design outer body components as per their requirements. They have necessary infrastructure and design team to undertake such job. The customers are ready to pay for the said services. Also, some of the reputed manufacturers of Laboratory products have proposed to avail the sales and marketing services of the experienced marketing team of the company. It will help the company in additional Forex Revenue generation without any outflow of the Indian currency and also better utilization of the resources.

The Director, thereafter, requested for inclusion of addition of the below mentioned services in their present LoA:-


- a. Developing and designing for Laboratory Equipment and consumables
- b. Providing sales and marketing related services.

On being asked to elaborate marketing services, the Director of the party explained that it is to provide marketing services to overseas distributors, who want their products to be marketed along with the products of the company M/s Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd.

The same was taken into cognizance by the committee in details as:-

- i. Designing laboratory equipments as per the specification of the overseas customers.
- ii. Manufacturing of the equipments, as per the specifications of the overseas customers.
- iii. Providing sales and marketing services for marketing of the laboratory equipments and consumables of overseas manufacturers to overseas customers.

The UAC directed to maintain separate accounts for the manufacturing and services of M/s. Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd. and it should be referred in this way in their APRs.




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After scrutiny of the agenda and discussion, the Approval Committee approved the said proposal of M/s Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd. and also gave their consent for issuance of Letter of Approval for the said proposal subject to submission of the undertaking that there is no dues pending regarding Income Tax/ Customs/ CGST/ Central Excise/ Service Tax issue.

35-A-02 Import of “ASG050 amorphous silicon thin film solar module” by M/s. Jenya, a new unit at Plot No. 10 in GIDC-EHTP & IT/ITES- SEZ, Gandhinagar which will be fixed on the outside of the building as a facade and at the completion of execution, the same will also generate electricity from Solar energy by connecting these panels with grid tie inverter

ShriJinendraShah, Director of the applicant firm M/s. Jenya, along with the technical consultant Shri. SharadParekhappeared before the Approval Committee for personal interview. He mentioned that his firm is presently holding Letter of Approval for authorized operations viz. services namely “IT/ITES-enabled services- (1. Location based marketing, 2 Engineering Drawings & 3. Other KPO Services).”The company is involved in business of service export. He plans to develop the building into self-sustained energy building i.e Green Building. He further submitted that he propose to import “425 Pcs. of ASG050 amorphous silicon thin film solar module valued at USD-31190.75 for the building of the company in the SEZ premises.” He explained that the said “amorphous silicon thin film solar module” will be used as a primary glass for façade. The glass module having amorphous layer on it, will be fixed on the toughen glass which will be further fixed on outer side of the building as a façade and the same will serve as a purpose of outer wall for existing building. He explained that the façade made out of such solar module will in turn produce electricity through solar energy, when connected with grid tie inverter. At the completion of such execution & approval from the o/o. the Electrical Inspector, Govt. of Gujarat and Distribution Company, this will be an additional electricity generation unit [grid connected] to the tune of 20KWp through solar energy, in addition to the existing solar power production of 27 KWp grid connected. He explained that since the total installed capacity will be 47KWp on completion, it will be less than 50% of connected load of 99.950KW at site as required by Gujarat Solar Power Policy 2015, principally and as claimed, it will be a **captive consumption in accounting terms**, although having grid connectivity with network of Distribution Company viz. M/s. Torrent Power Limited under **Net Metering Inter Connection Agreement**. He submitted that it will be a part of establishment cost, which will be offset wrt Foreign exchange achieved with the export of services. This cost will not make it NFF Negative, but he will be entitled for duty benefits, as per the provisos of the SEZ Act and Rules.

On being informed to the committee that the goods have been imported and lying uncleared by the Specified Officer, EP-SEZ at the port, the committee noted that the said unit has already imported the goods for which the Approval is still under consideration by the UAC. In past also, similar consignment was imported and post facto approval was requested by the said



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unit. Hence, the UAC took a strong cognizance that the unit is a repeated defaulter and it should be penalized accordingly. The Development Commissioner agreed to the suggestion and imposed a token penalty of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rs. Two Lakhs) on the said unit under the provisions of FTD&R Act, 1992.

After scrutiny of the agenda and discussion, the Approval Committee, however, approved the said proposal of M/s Jenya and also gave their consent for issuance of Letter of Approval for the said proposal subject to the payment of the Token penalty and submission of the undertaking that there is no dues pending regarding Income Tax/ Customs/ CGST/ Central Excise/ Service Tax and also that the firm give an undertaking that they will strictly abide by the laid down rules & provisions of SEZ.
