

MINUTES OF THE 38th (THIRTY EIGHTH) MEETING OF APPROVAL COMMITTEE FOR GIDC -ELECTRONIC PARK SEZ- GANDHINAGAR HELD ON FRIDAY, 26th JUNE, 2020 AT 15.30 HOURS UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DR. AMIYA CHANDRA, ZONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSIONER, KASEZ, AT KASEZ CITY OFFICE, AMBAWADI, AHMEDABAD-15

Approved minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed by the Approval Committee.

CASE-38-A-01

Application of M/s. Euro Circuits Pvt. Ltd. for Broadbanding/Inclusion of "Services" in the authorized list of items of manufacturing/services in present LoA issued vide Ref. No. KASEZ/P&C/6/10/06-07/13074 dated 14.03.2007, valid up to 25/7/2022.

Shri Bharat Verma, Plant Manager, & Mr. Manish Panchal, Import Export Manager, M/s. Euro Circuits Pvt. Ltd., Gandhinagar appeared for the interview before the UAC and introduced about the company. He stated that at present, the company is involved in physical manufacturing of Printed Circuit Boards. They have a great proficiency in the manufacturing of the PCB's and want to use this expertise to help other similar units in the world in manufacturing the PCB's by providing the services as mentioned in the agenda.

The Development Commissioner, asked about NIL additional cost provision, showing by the unit in their letter. According to the chairperson, the unit will have to certainly make some expenses towards to the cost of the required software which has not been reflected in the party's letter. To this the Company Representative replied that they will use the software of the companies to which they will provide services, through team viewer and amazon cloud.

The Development Commissioner asked to submit Comfort Letter of the details and consent/permission of such Companies to whom they intend to provide services for use of their licensed software, in the next meeting of Approval Committee and as of now, deferred the said request/proposal of the unit.

CASE-38-A-02

Request of M/s. Sypram Technology Pvt. Ltd., Gandhinagar for approval of the modification in shareholding pattern & Signature Authority. in Electronic Park SEZ, Gandhinagar

Shri Falgun Trivedi, General Manager, M/s. Sypram Technology Pvt. Ltd., Gandhinagar appeared for the personal interview before the UAC. The Development Commissioner asked whether the change in shareholding pattern has been intimated to Customs, Income Tax, ROC, Developer and other such agencies as required by the Company law, to which the Company representative could not answer. Thereafter, the Development Commissioner also asked if he is holding Authority Letter from the Company to represent their proposal in the Approval Committee to which the General Manager of the Company denied. Accordingly, the approval committee asked to put the matter in the next UAC after the intimation task to other agencies is completed by the Unit and thereby deferred the matter to the next UAC.

CASE-38-A-03

Request from M/s. Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd., Plot No. 16, GIDC EP-SEZ, Gandhinagar for Inclusion/addition of Land i.e. Plot no. 32, GIDC EP-SEZ, Gandhinagar in their LOA dated 26.02.2010.

Shri Bhupendra Shah, Director, M/s. Accumax Lab Devices Pvt. Ltd., appeared to represent the matter before the Approval Committee. The Approval Committee enquired about the export of the present products i.e. lab devices especially pipettes of various kind to which the director of the company explained in details. The Director of the company ensured that they will make every effort after acquiring the land to rise exports to 25% of the current year. The Approval Committee approved the said request of the unit for approval in respect of allotment of additional land by the Developer.

Thereafter, the Director also requested in respect of their proposal already submitted with a request to allow them for (i) Warehousing and (ii) Trading activity. The Director also explained that the export companies require basket products, to which imports and re-export as per requirements are necessary.

In the said matter, as regards to the request of the Unit for "Warehousing Activity", the Development Commissioner clearly informed that as per the current status of the said SEZ and in terms of the relevant provisions of SEZ law, such permission for warehousing activity to the said unit cannot be allowed/considered at this juncture. However, in respect to the request for the proposed Trading Activity, the Development Commissioner informed that the same may be allowed subject to the following conditions:

- The expression "trading" shall mean import for the purpose of re-export.
- The goods imported will have to be physically stored in a separate space, earmarked exclusively for the said purpose.
- Separate account will have to be maintained for these imported goods.
- Separate APR has to be filed for trading activity.

The Development Commissioner also directed the said Unit to submit the following details and to put up in the next UAC meeting:

- The architectural map of the present additional plot, showcasing a space earmarked exclusively to store the imported goods, which would subsequently to be re-exported as trading.
- Undertaking that Separate account will be maintained and separate APRs will be filed in respect of the said "Trading Activity".
- An affidavit that they will physically import such material, store it in the SEZ Unit and subsequently re-export (directly from the SEZ Unit to Port of Export) as per the requirement of the buyer. However, they will not sell/clear it to the Domestic Tariff Area.

CASE-38-B-1

Monitoring of Performance of SEZ units in GIDC's Electronics and IT/ITES- SEZ, in respect of performance up to the monitoring year 2018-19

The executive summary of Annual Performance Reports (APRs) – Cumulative Review up to the monitoring year 2018-19 (as on 31-03-2019) given in Annexure, in terms of Rule-54 of the SEZ Rules, 2006, were submitted for consideration and monitoring/review for 9 (nine) units. The UAC under the chairmanship of the Development Commissioner noted the same.

The Development Commissioner, on perusal, enquired about the details of any exports of M/s C S Laser LLP in the F.Y 2019-20 from the Jt. Development Commissioner and the Prev. Officer, to which they replied that the APR has not been received from the Unit, but no export has taken place from the said unit, to which the Development Commissioner directed to issue the SCN after look up into the matter.


The chairperson also enquired about the reason for ZERO NFE for two consecutive years by M/s. Orbit Software, to which the Jt. Development Commissioner replied that the unit is not operational in the SEZ, though its LoA is active and the NFE is positive. The DC directed to issue the SCN to the Unit as it is non-operational after taking LoA for EPSEZ.

CASE-38-Supplementary Agenda

Application of M/s. Caterpillar Signs Pvt. Ltd., Gandhinagar for setting up a new unit in Electronic Park SEZ, Gandhinagar

Nishant R. Shah, Director and Shri Sanjay Paliwala, President of M/s. Caterpillar Signs Pvt Ltd., Gandhinagar appeared in the personal interview to represent the unit. They introduced the company that it has become a 100 Cr. Company in the 10 years. They are involved in signage business and 94% business comes from US. They have got 500 products and are growing. To expand the capacity, they have purchased a plot in the SEZ area.

The DC enquired about the introduction of the new technology in their business to which the party replied that they are in the need based business and are continuously looking for growing opportunities. The Development Commissioner thereafter, gave valuable insights for the updating of technology. The Approval Committee, thereafter, approved the proposal subject to clearance from the GPCB.
