

MINUTES OF THE 39<sup>th</sup> (THIRTY NINTH) MEETING OF APPROVAL COMMITTEE FOR GIDC - AHMEDABAD APPAREL PARK SEZ- KHOKHRA, AHMEDABAD HELD ON WEDNESDAY, 24<sup>th</sup> June, 2019 AT 15.30 HOURS UNDER THE CHAIRMANSHIP OF DR. AMIYA CHANDRA, ZONAL DEVELOPMENT COMMISSIONER, KASEZ, AT KASEZ CITY OFFICE, AMBAWADI, AHMEDABAD-15

Approved minutes of the previous meeting were confirmed by members of the Unit Approval Committee.

**CASE-39-A-01**

Subject: - M/s. Artex Apparels, Ahmedabad Apparel Park - SEZ request for Broad-banding of their LOA for manufacture & export of cut piece Fabrics

Shri Chandulal D Mehta, Director and Shri Mahendra Shukla, Deputy Manager, M/s Artex Apparels appeared to represent the case of the unit. They informed to the Approval Committee that :-

1.1 Their unit was issued the Letter of Approval initially vide F.No. KASEZ/JP&C/6/43/07-08/4929 dated 06/8/2007 for undertaking authorized operations namely, manufacture of the items i.e "Readymade Garments."

1.2 Subsequently, after consideration of broad-banding request of their unit by the 37<sup>th</sup> Approval Committee meeting held on 22-01-2019, two additional items namely "cut pieces of fabrics" of 6 lakh meters and "clothing bags" with annual capacity of 50,000 pieces (falls under CTH as mentioned in Annexure 1) were also included in the list of items of manufacture.


2.1 Now, they have further requested for addition of some additional items, falls under the Chapter Headings as per Annexure B, in the aforesaid LoA. The said additional items are broadly "cut pieces of fabrics" and "clothing bags" of different kind of raw materials and accordingly falls under the respective CTH as mentioned in the above said Annexure B.

2.2 It was further clarified that the total quantity of the items to be manufactured and exports would remain the same i.e. "cut pieces of fabrics" of 6 lakh meters and "clothing bags", with annual capacity of 50,000 pieces, as per the projection submitted before the 37<sup>th</sup> Approval Committee meeting while considering their earlier broad-banding request as mentioned at above point No 1.2.

2.3 It is further submitted by the party that since the final product would be "cut pieces of fabrics" and "clothing bags" to be manufactured from different types of basic material/raw material, the manufacturing process will not be altered but the final product will falls under the respective Tariff Heading as mentioned in Annexure-B.

3.1 The Approval Committee under the chairmanship of the Zonal Development Commissioner, Shri Amiya Chandra, asked to confirm whether any of the items falls under the list

of restricted category items or otherwise. The unit representatives confirmed that all the items proposed to be manufactured are covered under the free category for import and export.

3.2 The Committee also enquired whether the imported raw materials/ clothes would be fresh or used, to which the Unit representatives stated that the same will be new only and in no case, old cloth will be imported. The Approval Committee asked for an affidavit confirming the same, to which the Unit Representatives readily agreed.

The Approval Committee agreed upon the proposal of the broadbanding.

**Case- 39-B-1**

Subject: - Application of M/s. Worldwide Safety (P) Ltd. for inclusion of Additional Items of Manufacturing (Broadbanding) in the existing LoA issued vide F.No. KASEZ/DCO/AAP-SEZ/11/003/2014-15 dated 19/12/2014 valid till 15/01/2022.

Mr Sandeep Kakkar, CEO, M/s Worldwide Safety (P) Ltd. along with his aide, Shri Mayank appeared to represent the case of the unit located at AAP-SEZ, Ahmedabad.

1. He informed to the members of the Unit Approval Committee that in the present Letter of Approval, the items of manufacturing, approved by the UAC are "Seamless Knitted Gloves and Seamless Knitted dipped gloves in plastic (HSN Code: 61169300)".

2. The party representative then informed that the SEZ based unit now plans to include two "Additional Items" of Manufacturing in the present Letter of Approval issued vide F.No. KASEZ/DCO/AAP-SEZ/11/003/2014-15 dated 19/12/2014, which is valid till 15/01/2022 and requested to allow Synthetic knitted dipped gloves (HSN Code: - 61161000) and Synthetic knitted sleeves (HSN Code: - 61178090), in the present LoA. The proposed items are in huge demand in the international market and that the existing machinery installed in the factory premises is sufficient for the manufacturing of the said two additional items.


3. Thereafter the Unit Representatives showed the products to the Approval Committee. They informed that the items are in the Free list and the raw materials like P.E-Fibre and Spandex bare yarn will be imported. There is no requirement to import any Capital Goods. Also the party representative stated that the sleeves are normally used in automobile industry to prevent any cut to the hand as the finished products are cut resistant.

4. The Approval Committee also took a note that at present the party has got a positive NFE of Rs. 11.73 crores.

5. Thereafter, the Approval Committee agreed upon the proposal of the broadbanding.


**Case 39-E-01**


