The Committee asked the applicant that why they require 5 KL of water per day for their trading and warehousing activities. In reply Shri Kapdi stated that they require 5 KL water for sanitisation and cleaning of the unit due to current Covid-19 Pandemic.

The Approval Committee after due deliberation decided to approve the proposal for trading and warehousing service activity subject to standard terms and conditions: -

- i) The approval is subject to the additional condition that the applicant should seek a prior approval of any additional items they intend to warehouse and submit KYC details of clients to the Office of the Development Commissioner before undertaking the authorised warehousing activity.
- ii) Further, none of the items which are restricted or prohibited will be allowed to be traded/warehoused and any restrictions on import/export of any items will apply unless specifically permitted by the UAC.
- iii) The items falling under Chapter 72 & 73 will be subject to compulsory registration under Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS).
- iv) Further, with respect to traded/warehoused item at Sr. No. 33 the same is allowed to be traded/warehoused provided Import CIF value is Rs. 720/- per kg or more, for item at Sr. No. 34, the same is allowed to be traded/warehoused provided that the import CIF value is Rs. 680/- per Kg or more, for item at Sr. No. 15, the same is allowed to be traded/warehoused provided that the import CIF value is Rs. 251/- per Kg or more.
- v) Further, with respect to item at Sr. No. 19 viz. Nutritional Supplements, it is directed that the applicant needs to give an undertaking that the warehoused goods will be re-exported to the tune of 75% to 80% and also whenever any warehoused goods are cleared into DTA the same shall be subject to compliance of FSSAI norms and all other statutory compliance viz. NOC from Animal Husbandry Department, etc. before such clearance.
- vi) Further, with respect to item at Sr. No. 38, the same is allowed subject to fulfilment of food standard requirements prescribed under any Act/Rules from concerned agencies.
- vii) Further, no cleaning and excessive use of water will be permitted for the said trading/warehousing activities.
- viii) In case of any discrepancy/mismatch between the above 'Description of Goods' as provided by the Unit & 'Description of goods as per DGFT Import Policy', the later will prevail.
- ix) Further, the items will be subjected to the Policy Conditions specified in DGFT's ITC HS Code wherever applicable.
- x) The above permission is also subject to further condition that the unit shall maintain separate accounts for trading and warehousing service activity and earmark separate space for both the activities and submit map of demarcated area.
- xi) Further, the applicant will submit separate APRs for both of their trading and warehousing service activities.
- xii) Further, the applicant will maintain separate stock register for trading and warehousing which will be subject to regular checking by the KASEZ customs authorities.

- xiii) Further, the applicant will obtain registration/clearance/any other mandatory requirement prescribed under any Act/Rules from concerned agencies before undertaking of such activities.
- xiv) Further, the applicant will give an undertaking that none of the items proposed above are falling under negative list and are not hazardous or require environmental clearance for storage/transmission/handling and if the items are found in negative list or hazardous in nature, penal action will be initiated against them.

The Approval Committee after due deliberation approved the proposal of manufacturing activity subject to standard terms and conditions for such units which include no DTA Sale/clearance of any manufactured goods and no import of Betel nuts (supari) and also subject to furnishing an affidavit/undertaking for use of plastic packaging as detailed under Item No. 117.1.2 in terms of the Apex Court's judgement. Further, the Committee also approved the proposal for warehousing service activity subject to standard terms and conditions.

- i) Any restrictions on import/export of above items and its raw materials will apply.
- ii) Further, none of the items which are restricted or prohibited will be allowed to be warehoused and any restrictions on import/export of any items will apply unless specifically permitted by the UAC.
- iii) The approval is subject to the additional condition that the applicant should seek a prior approval of any additional items they intend to warehouse and submit KYC details of clients to the Office of the Development Commissioner before undertaking the authorised warehousing activity.
- iv) Further, with respect to warehoused item at Sr. No. 17 to 20 the same is allowed to be warehoused provided that the import CIF value is Rs. 251/- per Kg or more.
- v) Further, item falling under Chapter 72 and 73 will be subject to compulsory registration under Steel Import Monitoring System (SIMS).
- vi) Further, with respect to warehoused items at Sr. No. 13 to 15, the same is allowed subject to fulfilment of all mandatory requirement prescribed under any Act/Rules from concerned agencies.
- vii) In case of any discrepancy/mismatch between the above 'Description of Goods' as provided by the Unit & 'Description of goods as per DGFT Import Policy', the later will prevail.
- viii) Further, the items will be subjected to the Policy Conditions specified in DGFT's ITC HS Code wherever applicable.

Monitoring of ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REPORT (APR) for the Financial Year 2018-19, as per provisions of Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006

As per Rule 54 of the SEZ Rules, 2006, the performance of the units shall be monitored by the Approval Committee as per the guidelines given under Annexure appended to these rules.

The Committee perused the status, in respect of 255 units placed before them. The Committee noted out of 255 working units, 234 units have submitted APRs and 21 units have not submitted APRs for the year 2018-19. Further, out of 234 units who have submitted APRs, 27 units have failed to achieve positive Net Foreign Exchange Earnings and out of 27 units who have failed to achieve positive NFE, 16 units have failed to achieve positive NFE in their 1st& 2nd year of their 5 year block period; 9 units have failed to achieve positive NFE in 3rd and 4th year of their 5 year block period and 2 units have failed to achieve positive NFE in 5th year of their 5 year block period.

The Committee noted that in respect of the NFE negative cases at the end of 5th year of their 5 year block period that SCNs have already been issued in respect of 1 unit viz. Proactive Ecyler Pvt. Ltd. and adjudication has also been completed.

After due deliberation, the Approval Committee directed the DC's office to take following actions as under: -

1. To issue SCN to M/s. Sameer Industries who failed to achieve positive NFE in 5th year of their 5 year block period.
2. To issue SCN to 9 units who have failed to achieve positive NFE in 3rd& 4th year of their 5 year block period.
3. To place the 16 units who failed to achieve positive NFE in their 1st& 2nd year of their 5 year block period under the watch list as per monitoring guidelines.
4. UAC decided that non-submission of APRs despite repeated reminder even after lapse of more than one year beyond 180 days of time period of submission of APRs is violation of BLUT condition and also of Rule 22 of SEZ Rules, 2006. Therefore, UAC decided to issue SCN to these 21 erring units for imposition of penalty under FT (D&R) Act, 1992 read with Rule 54 of SEZ Rules, 2006.
5. The Committee directed to seek clarification from the 45 units in whose APRs discrepancies were pointed out by the Auditor and if
